

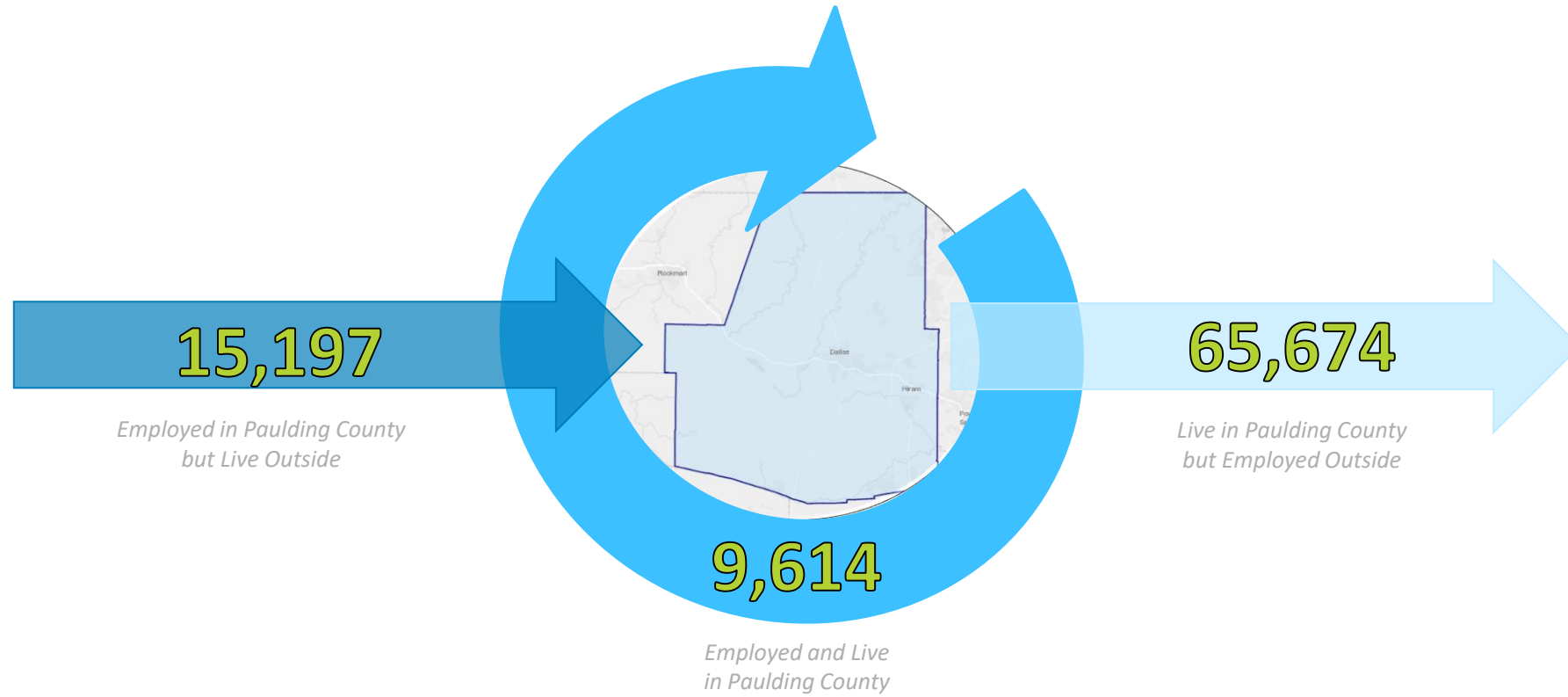

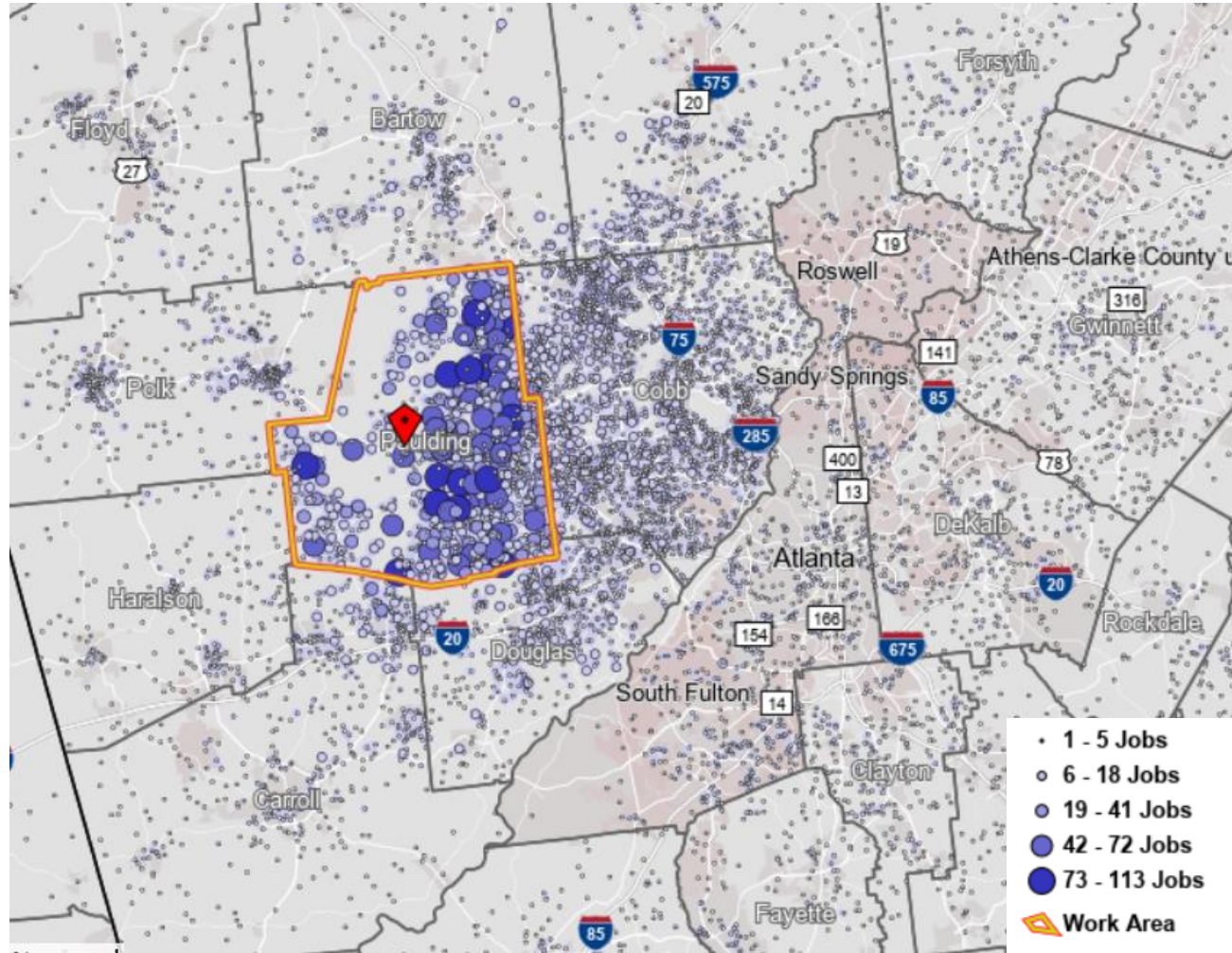

Inflow/Outflow



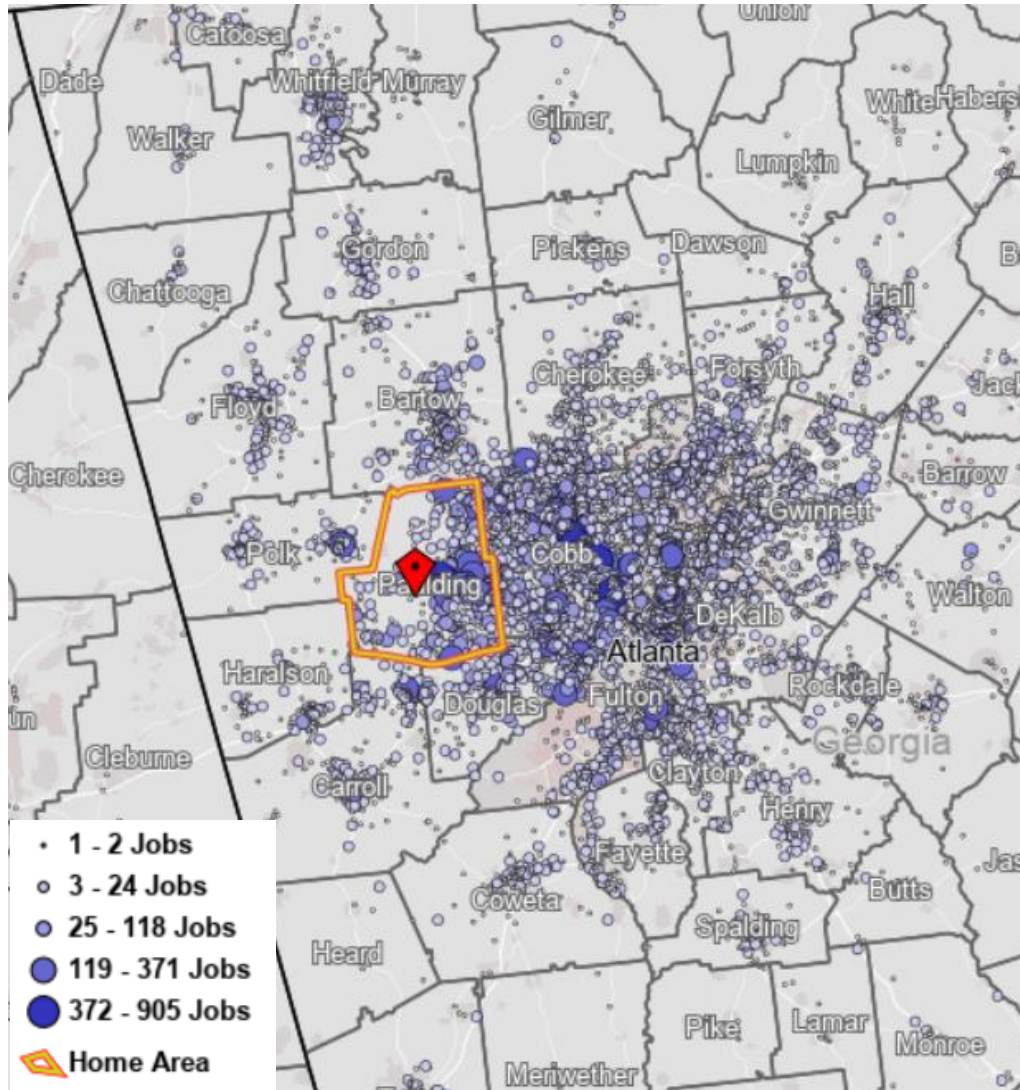
Inflow/Outflow: Labor Shed
